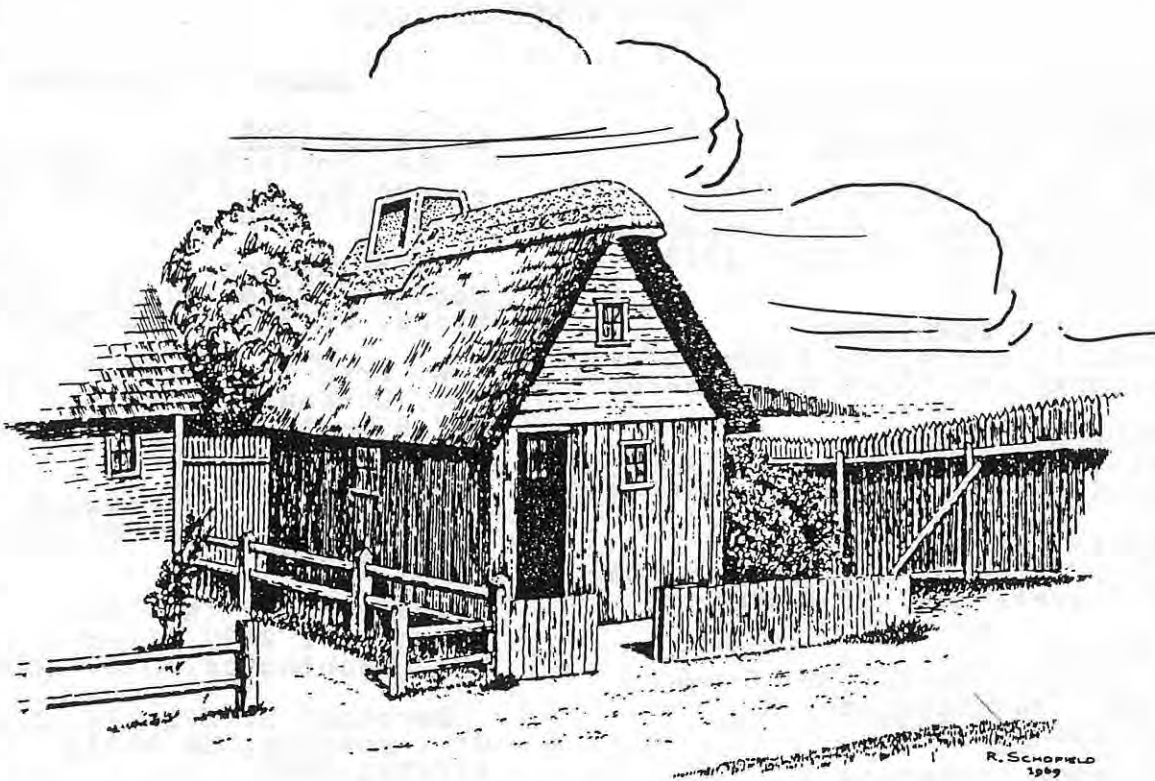

I am in-line to become President of Sons of the Revolution In Minnesota. I want to do that and likely will; health and providence allowing.


This is not a message of farewell, for I am not going away! I remain a Director and a Life Member who expects to retain an active, caring interest in our family for the remainder of my lifetime.

In Memoriam

HENRY HORNBLOWER II
1917-1985

Members and friends of Plimoth Plantation were saddened to learn of the death of Henry Hornblower II, founder and chairman of the board of the museum. Mr. Hornblower died on Sunday, October 20, at Mt. Auburn Hospital, Cambridge, after suffering a heart attack. He was 67.

A fourth generation member of his family in the securities business, Mr. Hornblower was vice president of Shearson, Lehman Bros. Inc. For many years he was a partner in Hornblower & Weeks-Hemphill, Noyes before a series of mergers led to the firm's present title. The original company was founded by his great grandfather, Edward T. Hornblower, and was known as Hornblower & Page.

Although his professional life was spent as a stockbroker, he "was an incurable enthusiast, with an unquenchable enthusiasm for books, maps, travel, archeology and history in general," according to Sinclair Hitchings, keeper of prints at the Boston Public Library and a close friend and admirer.

The idea of recreating the way of life of the early settlers had been with Mr. Hornblower since childhood. After Army service in World War II, he set about making his dream come true. He persuaded his father, Ralph Hornblower, to give the Pilgrim Society \$20,000 to acquire land and prepare preliminary plans for a Pilgrim Village.

In October 1947, they established a nonprofit corporation named Plimoth Plantation, Inc., to receive the fund. "Our goal was simple," Mr. Hornblower said. "We just wanted to tell the Pilgrim story."

Under his leadership, the Plantation's annual budget grew from \$2,000 to almost \$3 million today, with 62 fulltime and 110 seasonal employees. Now a major outdoor living history museum, the Plantation has attracted nearly 25 million visitors from all parts of the world.

"Henry Hornblower was a leader and idealist whose inspiration will be missed by all those affiliated with Plimoth Plantation," said director David K. Case. "He was immensely proud of the Plantation's growth during the last 38 years. Certainly the museum's continued vitality will be a lasting memorial to this gentleman of remarkable vision and commitment"

Rebecca F. Soule (Becky), 80, a retired Marriage Chapel director, died suddenly on June 19 of a heart failure.

As a very active community minded and caring lady she placed her efforts and energy in many clubs, her church and organizations. Her main interests were with the senior citizen Golden Age Club of Greenbelt, Prince Georges County Seasoned Players, Holy Cross Lutheran Church Bible class, Prince Georges College Senior Citizen Fitness and Recreation Program, Polka Dancers of Good Luck Road Recreation Center, Weight Watchers (life time membership), and the Clowns of America Club. As a regular visitor to many nursing homes she helped with the patients' needs and comfort and had founded her personal prayer list of over a hundred names for those seeking help through prayers.

For the last three years Becky had entered the Maryland Senior Olympics and each year won gold and silver medals for speed walking and basketball foul throws. She was one of the first senior citizens to be honored with an award at the Prince Georges County-Breakfast of Champions.

She is survived by her husband, Harold Soule, a research scientist. The couple lived in Springhill Lake on Edmonston Road. Her daughter Suzanne and an adopted son, Dan, and sister, Mary, all of California also survive.

The National Secondary Education Council announced June 6, 1985 that Donna Stubblefield has been named as Academic All-American. This program was established to offer deserved recognition to superior students who excell in Academic discipline. Scholars must earn a 3.3 or better grade point average. Donna had maintained a 4.0 grade point average for the 84-85 school year. Students are selected by a secondary school instructor, counselor, or other qualified sponsor. Donna, who attends Gay Junior High School in Harlingen, Texas, was nominated by her English teacher, Miss Mildred Bounds. This is the second year Donna has been recognized for this award.

Last month Harlingen C.I.S.D. recognized Donna as one of their top students on the secondary level. She was named as one of the top four students honored from over 750 eighth graders. MEET YOUR OFFICERS

RONALD J. SOULE - Board Member - Class of 1988

Ron was born in Randolph, VT 19 January 1933. He graduated from Randolph High School in 1951. From there, he attended Bowling Green State University, finishing in 1955 with a BA in journalism.

He was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant through the Air Force ROTC, and reported for active duty in October 1955. He completed USAF Pilot Training in December 1956. From then until June 1964 he had various flying assignments as a squadron fighter pilot and combat crew instructor in F-84 and F-100 aircraft. From July 1964 to January 1968 he was an Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies, Miami University, Oxford, Ohio. He served in Southeast Asia as a squadron fighter pilot flying the A-1 Skyraider with the 1st Air Commando Squadron during 1968-1969.



From July 1969 to March 1972, he was at Combat Operations Center, Kadena AB, Okinawa, flying T-33's and the F-105. From April 1972 to July 1977 he had duty in Texas and Europe as Director of Logistics. While in Europe, he was chief of the NATO Programs Division and served as the Chief negotiator for Logistic Support Agreements between the USAF and our NATO allies.

In July 1977 he became Director of Airborne Battlestaff and Battlestaff Operations Officer, 7th Airborne Command and Control Squadron, Keesler AFB, MS. He retired from active duty in 1981 after 25 years service-- Command Pilot with over 4,000 flying hours. He is currently Aerospace Science Instructor and Director of the Air Force Junior ROTC Program, St. Paul's High School, Covington, LA. He is married to Nancy, and they have three children: Rhonda, Michael, and Scott.

Some of Ron's military awards and decorations: Silver Star, Distinguished Flying Cross (2), Air Medal (12), Meritorious Service Medal (2), Air Force Commendation Medal, Republic of Viet Nam Cross of Gallantry, Combat Readiness Medal, Presidential Unit Citation (3), Outstanding Unit Award (4), Viet Nam Service Medal.

In Ron's words: *Naturally, aviation/aerospace/Air Force continues to be of major interest to me. Although I hold FAA commercial and instructor ratings for single and multi-engined aircraft, my flying is strictly a hobby/interest and not a business....Other interests include photography, model rocketry, golf and skiing (snow, downhill). I used to be an avid golfer, but found that there were many other things in life just as interesting as golf, and ever since have managed to keep the golf bug under control. My current favorite pastime is cruising around these great United States every summer in our motorhome. This was our third summer on the road, and so far we have visited 42 of our 50 states. We really enjoyed the visit with our "cousins" this summer-- had a great stay in Minnesota."*

NOTES FROM OUR HISTORIAN

Dr. Terry has been busy answering letters and replying to queries. He's also been working on the Soule Preliminary Index-2. This is an index to all those persons with a Soule (or variant) name in our Soule Kindred records. These records include material gathered by Colonel John Soule and preserved in notebooks, card files and letter files; they have been added to and updated since Col. John's death. Ridlon's Soule History, Soule Kindred Newsletter, Mayflower Index (published by the General Society of Mayflower Descendants), Mayflower Families 3 - George Soule, and various vital records have also been abstracted for the index. Corrections and additions to the first preliminary index which have been received will be included. It is anticipated that the second index will be available in early spring, probably in an 8 1/2 by 11 size for putting in a notebook. Dr. Terry would also like to know whether there would be interest in making the index available on a floppy disk for computer. Please contact him or the editor about this.

To facilitate research and record-keeping, Dr. Terry would like to reiterate that when you send information to him, you include place names as well as dates for vital records. Please have your name and address as submitter on the material sent. If you are doing genealogical research, be aware of the differences between birth, marriage, and death records. Birth and marriage records were made at the time of the event by persons involved in the event. Information on death records is supplied by an "informant", and is not always reliable regarding early events in the deceased's life (birth, parents, marriage data).

Soule Kindred is aware of early New England Soules who were not descendants of Pilgrim George. We would welcome information on these persons to add to our files, but we are unable to do research on the collateral lines.

FAMILY DATA FORM

Soule Kindred needs information, especially on families since 1800. We'd like to suggest that you begin with your 6th generation ancestor from George Soule (or your earliest Soule ancestor, if you haven't made the connection to George-1). Fill out a form for that ancestor, and then submit forms for each of your ancestors down to yourself. This is especially important if you descend through a female line; Soule women who marry tend to become lost Soules.

Directions for recording data on the form were printed in V. 16, No. 4, October, 1982 Newsletter. It is VERY important to list sources of data; if the information comes from a family Bible or other record, a photocopy of the information should be included. Send completed form to our Historian:

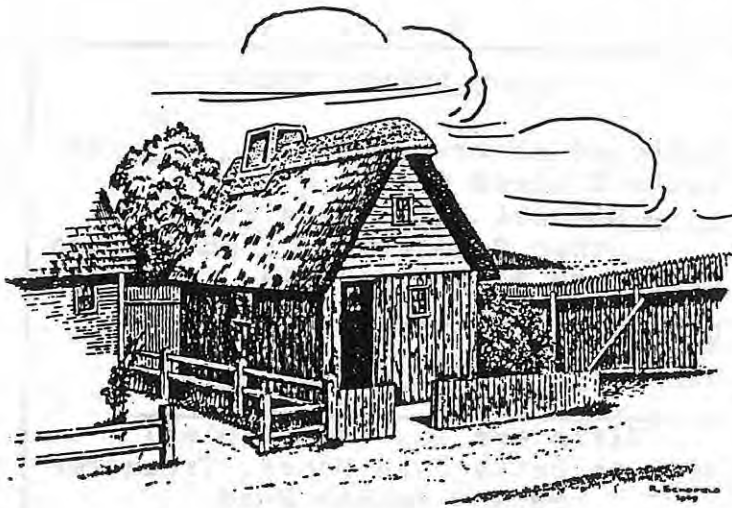
