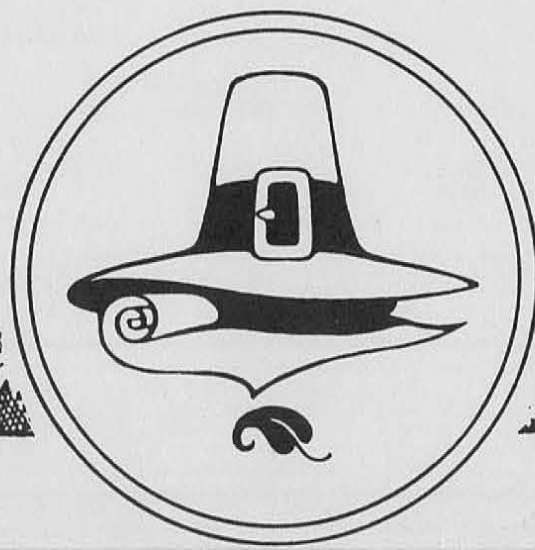

## PRESIDENT'S PEN


Dear Cousins:

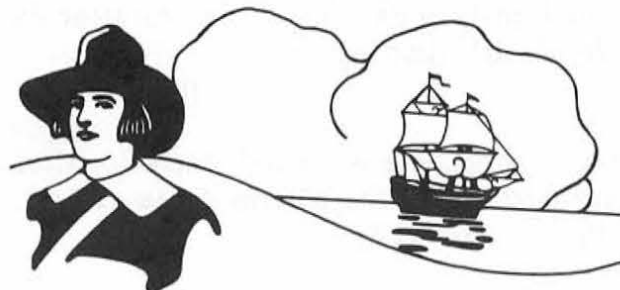

PLIMOTH PLANTATION

§ Late in 1620 a group of Englishmen landed in the New World after a stormy 66 day voyage across the North Atlantic in a small ship - the Mayflower. They had left the homes and land they loved seeking a place to worship as their consciences directed. George Soule was one of this group.

§ These Pilgrims built a colony which they called Plimoth Plantation or New Plimouth. Their Colony and their ideals have been firmly planted into the hearts and history of America. In securing their own freedom of con-

science, the Pilgrims set a pattern which was duplicated by many other pilgrims of many different creeds who followed to a new life in our country.

§ In 1947 a new Plimoth Plantation, a non-profit educational organization, was founded to create an understanding of our ancestors. Using old records and eyewitness accounts of visitors to the original colony, Plimoth Plantation is being recreated as it looked in 1627, some seven years after the Pilgrims landed at Plymouth Rock. This new Plimoth Plantation is a full-scale functioning village where guides and hostesses demonstrate the daily life of the 17th century. In this setting the visitor may see the Pilgrims as people who mortgaged themselves and their future for an ideal. Here one can understand the courage and faith of our forefathers - and that is the avowed purpose of the new Plimoth Plantation, located just two miles south of famed Plymouth Rock in Plymouth, Massachusetts.

§ Plimoth Plantation also owns and exhibits the Mayflower II - the Pilgrim Shallop, the First House and 1627 House, all on the waterfront near Plymouth Rock.

§ The replica of George Soule's house has recently been completed and was dedicated 12 September 1966. A descendant, Horace Homer Soule III, officiated for the dedication of the house. He presented a brief biography of our Mayflower ancestor, then

visited a neighboring house in the village, gathered a pan of coals from the fireplace and with them lit the first fire on the new hearth. Cranberry juice and corn bread were then distributed to the enjoyment of all attending. When are you going to visit this fascinating and hallowed place?

It pleases me when I can introduce close cousins who are unaware of each other. Such was the case with Louise Hickey of Wyoming and Catherine Morton of Kansas. Catherine had sent me several generations of family sheets for our files, so when Louise wrote to ask for help with her ancestors in Kansas, I was able to give her Catherine's name. They are 2nd cousins once removed, their common ancestor being Sardine<sup>7</sup> Soule (Almond<sup>6</sup>, Asa<sup>5</sup>, Micah<sup>4</sup>, Josiah<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, George<sup>1</sup>). Perhaps others of you have this lineage. I'm sure that either of these ladies would be willing to correspond with you. They are both Kindred members: Catherine (Cooper) Morton, 2707 Jackson, Wichita, KS, 67204, and Louise (Soule) Hickey, P.O. Box 3172, Gillette, WY 82717.

In a similar manner I was able to put Mary Elizabeth (Clark) Jones and Robert M. Gerrity in touch with each other. They are descendants of Patience<sup>2</sup> (Soule) Haskell.

Bob Gerrity has sent me a "Descendancy Chart" for Silas<sup>5</sup> Paine, generated on computer by the LDS's Personal Ancestry File. (Silas Paine is #1016 in Mayflower Families 3.) I am publishing this chart in this Newsletter, and requesting others who can produce similar charts from their 5th generation ancestor to send to me. They need not be done on computer. My own computer program, Family Roots, prints a descendancy chart which is not as condensed-- I generated 31 pages from my 5th generation ancestor.

Bob suggests that we publish these "Fifth Generation Descendancy Charts" as a regular feature of the Newsletter. It is a compact way of presenting a significant number of names, and would help both Soule Kindred members and general researchers to know of others who might be researching the same lines. So PLEASE send me your descendancy charts; if we can't print them, we'll keep them on file.

RECORDING OF FAMILY DATA

By Geraldine Sowle Schlosser, Soule Kindred Historian

One of the objectives of Soule Kindred is the gathering of information pertaining to the descendants of Pilgrim George Soule. Mayflower Families 3 covers the first 5 generations, to about 1800. Our families did a lot of moving around in the 19th century, and you can help locate migration patterns for family groups. That is why the Family Data Chart is printed in each issue of the Newsletter. Our historian may be able to help you with that "missing link". So please keep the information coming.

We would like to suggest that you begin with your sixth generation ancestor from George Soule (or your earliest Soule ancestor, if you haven't made the connection to George<sup>1</sup>). Fill out a form for that ancestor, and then submit forms for each of your ancestors down to yourself. This is especially important if you descend through a female line; Soule women who marry tend to become lost Soules.

We'll give a short explanation of how to fill out the form. Samples were printed in V. 20, #2 and #3-- April and July, if you'd like to refer to those.

(1) The "Generation" space in the upper left corner shows the generation from the immigrant ancestor. Please leave it blank unless you are certain.

(2) In the far upper space on the right for "FAMILY", leave it blank if the surname of "Soule Descendant" is SOULE, SOWLE, or variants, because we'll assign a code number for closely related family groups. If the "Soule Descendant" has a different surname, insert the name in the right upper space.

(3) The next two lines show the ancestors of the "Soule Descendant" back to George Soule<sup>1</sup>. Unless you have an approved Mayflower Lineage or other positive proof, we suggest this be left blank.

(4) When writing dates, follow the genealogical style-- first the day in numbers, then the month in letters, and the full year, such as 6 Feb 1833.

(5) When listing children on the reverse side, put in as much information as you can-- such as spouse's parents, if known.

(6) List your name and address as compiler unless someone else gathers the information. We may need to contact the compiler.

(7) It is VERY important to list sources of data; if the information comes from a family Bible or other record, a photocopy of the information should be included. Other sources, such as Vital Records from towns or states, and census should be indicated.

(8) Leave "Verification" blank for our purposes.

(9) Please give as many clues as possible to facilitate further research. If you are uncertain about a date, enter it, but add "circa" or "ca". For questionable place names, add "possibly" or "probably".

# Soule named Paul Revere president

MIDDLEBORO - Charles E. Soule, son of Alberta N. Soule, of 116 Oak St., has been elected president of Paul Revere Insurance Group by the companies' various boards of directors. He will assume his duties this month. The announcement was made by Textron Inc., parent company of The Paul Revere.

Soule joined the Worcester-based firm in 1956 as a disability insurance underwriter. During his 34 year career with The Paul Revere, he has served in many areas including individual insurance, group, annuity, and disability reinsurance operations. He became vice president in 1971 and senior vice president in 1980. He currently serves as executive vice president having been elected to the post in 1983. Soule was elected to the companies' boards of directors in 1981.

Soule was one of the senior management team who devised the

company's nationally acclaimed quality process.

Soule has been very active in civic and local affairs. He has served as a member of the board of directors for the Worcester Area Chamber of Commerce, and in 1986 he was elected chairman. He is past chair for the Alliance for Education, and is a member of the board of directors and executive committee for the Worcester Business Development Corporation.

Soule has been active in Boy Scouts of America and is a recipient of the silver Beaver Award. He is a corporator, trustee and chairman of the audit committee of the Westborough Savings Bank, and a member of the board of trustees for Mechanics Hall.

Soule also served on many industry related committees during his 34-year career at Paul Revere. He served as chair of the Federal

Programs Committee of the Health Insurance Association of America (HIAA) and the Disability Committee. He is past president of the National Association of Health Underwriters, Disability Income Training Council. He was a member of the Congressional Commission on the Evaluation of Pain for the Social Security Administration.

Prominent in the disability income industry Soule, in 1984, authored a textbook, "Disability Income Insurance: The Unique Risk." A second edition was released in late 1988. He has also written many articles for industry publications.

He graduated from Memorial High School in 1952 and earned a bachelor of arts degree from Dartmouth College in 1956.

Soule and his wife Elna Eayrs Soule, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Frederick Eayrs of 60 School St., Middleboro, live in Westboro. They have four children.

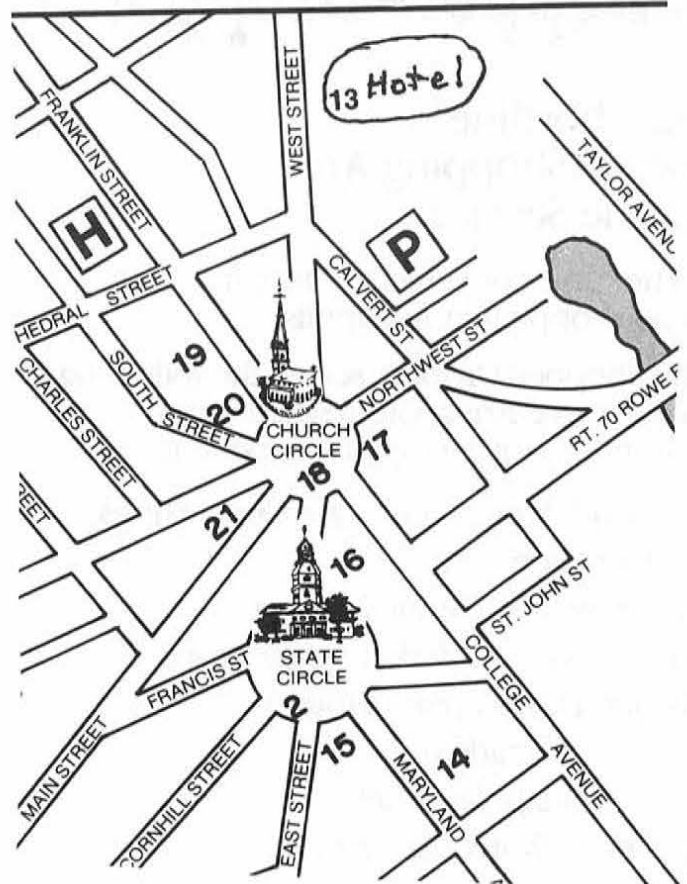

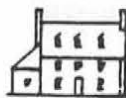

Ed. Note: This letter from Anita Stong represents a magnificent contribution to the essential purposes of SOULE KINDRED in AMERICA. That is to provide assistance to those Soule cousins who are attempting to close a line to our common ancestor George Soule, Mayflower passenger. She has done the work, and now offers her research to the Kindred. Anyone having information on Rev Abraham Soule and Thankful W. Allen line should be in touch with Anita Stong.

This reprinting of the Article HISTORICAL BACKGROUND is from the first issue of the SOULE KINDRED NEWSLETTER. On this our Twenty-fifth Anniversary we should be as well informed on the roots of our common ancestor as possible. This article discusses some the facts and myths of the history of our family. Many of the issues raised here still remain just myths, as yet unproved. Ed.

### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

§ The name of SOULE is of ancient origin - a fact true of all surnames. Some earlier authorities have contended that our name came from that of the fish; others allege it was derived from the local title for a pond in Kent County, England. To us, a more plausible theory is that it originated in the ancient Basque province of Soule which lay astride the present mountainous border between France and Spain. Certainly, it is far from being an uncommon name in France today, although the French use the accent SOULÉ in both spelling and pronunciation. We do know that the immigrant ancestor for most of us, George Soule of the Mayflower, was from England. That fact presents no obstacle to the theory that the family is of French origin. There is evidence that a member of the family accompanied William the Conqueror (if one adheres to English history; or William the Bastard if one prefers the French version) from Normandy to England in 1066. This is far from the only opportunity for migration as the history of France and England were closely interwoven for centuries. One need only recall that the English cow remained in the stable while the French boeuf became beef; the sheep also stayed in the language of the farm while mutton came to the dining room. As this is written, we have little hope of any deeper exploration of the early Soule background. However, if any member of our organization has the knowledge, experience, patience, and financial resources to dig out the facts and provide adequate documentation, it will be a pleasure to publish such information for the benefit of all concerned.

§ The story of our forefathers is the story of America, from the earliest Colonial days through the formative years of the United States to the present days. We find our ancestors serving in the earliest wars, filling important positions in local governments, men of substance, but with a wanderlust. They were seamen and fishermen, farmers and trades people. They followed the great Quaker migrations of the 1730s to Western Connecticut and Dutchess County, New York; and even farther to North Carolina. These movements undoubtedly were part of the urge to find more, better, and cheaper land - even though it might mean privation and hardship. Members of the family were there when our frontiers advanced slowly Westward. Soules have always been pioneers. Starting from Massachusetts we have found them in Maine, upstate Vermont, and New York before the American Revolution. By the time of the first United States Census in 1790 there were 115 families of the Soule-Sowle name or variants enumerated in twelve states comprising some 641 individuals. Hundreds more bore other surnames even though still legitimate descendants of George Soule. But to go on with our story, we know that at least one Soule family was in Ohio shortly after 1800, another in Indiana about ten years later, several in Michigan by 1830 and literally dozens followed the Gold Rush to California and are enumerated in the 1850 Census of that state.

§ Research into the detailed biographical story of these people is fascinating but frustrating. Outside of Massachusetts and some of the Maine towns, records were poorly kept if at all. Some states did not even begin to record vital statistics until 1923. Graves were frequently marked by field stones without inscription placed in a corner of the farm, then the stones were removed by subsequent tenants of the premises. Invaluable family tradition is rendered suspect by substantial variance from recorded history. It is our hope, with your help and cooperation, that it may be possible to continue collecting the facts and publish an authoritative and fully documented genealogy of the descendants of George Soule of the Mayflower in this series of quarterly newsletters. Save them.

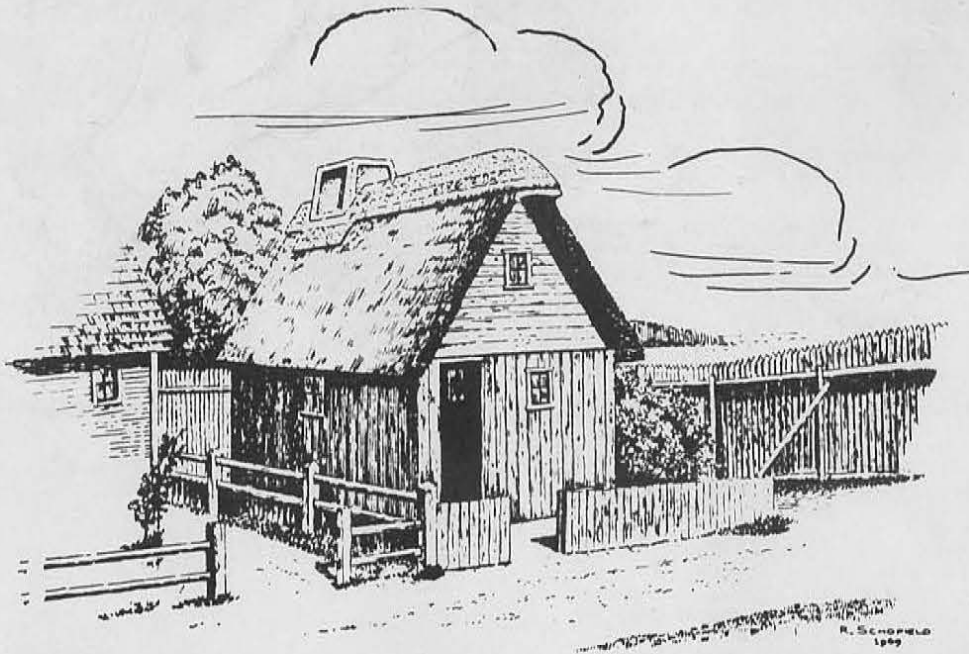
