

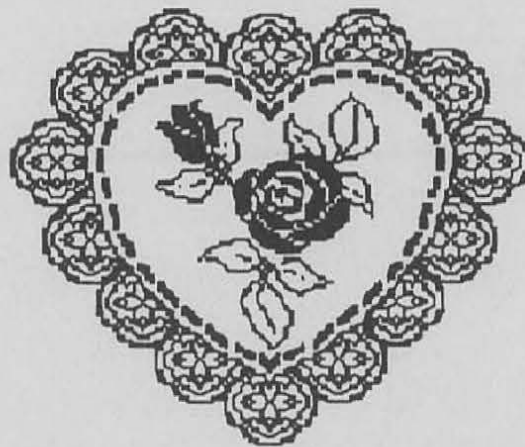


The "Query" column is very helpful to those who are seeking their roots or looking for "lost Souls," as I was once. In other words, more Soule participation, pleas.

FAMILY HISTORIAN'S REPORT

I want to extend Happy New Year's wishes to all of our members. One of my personal resolutions is to try to catch up on the backlog of correspondence, which at times overwhelms me. If you are waiting for a response, please be patient.

* * * * *

Some of you who were at the August reunion knew that I was planning to do research on WILLIAM SOWLE⁵ (#443 in MF3). His parentage has been disallowed by the Mayflower Society because the grave of a William Sowle of the same age was discovered in Maine, and he is presumed to be the son of Ezekiel. I was attempting to find another father for William (#443). We visited Spencertown, NY and talked with a town historian, but were unable to find where William had come from. There was quite a bit of material on another branch of the Soule family living in Columbia County, but nothing on William. Then we went to Alburg, VT and consulted records there. William's family there is very thoroughly covered, but nothing about where he came from. I have deduced from the spelling of his name (with a "w") that he came from either Tiverton, RI or Dartmouth, MA, but vital records in those places have not helped us either. I will keep working on this as time permits, and will welcome any suggestions from any genealogists out there.

* * * * *

When we were in New York we stopped in Albany and picked up more Soule Kindred records from Betty-Jean Haner. These include Col. John Soule's "red books" and his card files. The red books have not been added to since the mid-70's, when Col. John was actively working on the Mayflower book. The card files were in a bit of disarray which probably occurred at the time that they were microfilmed. I also had already received a number of cards which belonged there. I have sorted these cards (9 file drawers) and added some. This file is very useful in tracing Soule descendants-- but only those with a SOULE or variant surname.

* * * * *

I have been in correspondence with Don Steel who is the chairperson for The Sole Society in England. This is a newly-formed one-name society which is attempting to trace and record the genealogy and family history of families of SOLE (and variants) anywhere in the world, but especially the origins and development of this group of surnames in the U.K. They will publish a journal three times a year. I have joined the organization, partly in hopes that something will turn up in their files on the parentage of our George. I'm including an application form in this newsletter for those of you who may wish to join. If you do not want to get a money order for pounds sterling (quite costly), they will accept £5 and £10 notes. Any sum above the amount due will be credited either as a donation or loan. I believe you can get these notes at a bank-- I still had some from our Soule Kindred trip.

From Barbara E. Wallace of Traverse City, Michigan:

She writes of an error that needs to be corrected to the 1991 Board Meeting in Annapolis.

"The improvements to the cemetery were not made by the Town of Fairfield, but by my cousin, Allen Corliss, of St. Albans, Vt. Allen returned to the area in 1989 after living in Florida of 10 or 12 years, and being very interested in his family history, went to visit the grave of his ancestor, Joseph Soule, the first Soule to settle in Fairfield in 1791. He could barely beat his way through the brambles, small trees, and grass that had overgrown the cemetery. He returned a few days later armed with a chain saw and scythe, and after cutting down the trees, was able to begin clearing away the grass and brambles with his scythe. He returned as often as he could during that summer to work on it, then continued with the project during the summers of 1990 and 1991. However, he made the mistake of leaving his scythe hooked up in a tree rather than to lug it home with him each time, and when he returned to work on the cemetery one day last summer, he discovered that someone had stolen his scythe. That ended his work on the cemetery.. "

Barbara continues by writing, "Allen has spent years compiling data on his branch of the Soule Family, and probably knows more about the old graveyards in that area than anyone else. I just thought that credit should be given where credit is due."

Our Soule courage: "Sybil Mattson, daughter of Jeanette (Soule) Friedland and mother of Deborah (Mattson) Jerome cannot be a very active member of Soule Kindred.. She had been paralyzed since August 1955, when she was struck () by polio in the terrible epidemic of that year.

There was no cure. The "iron lung" kept Sybil breathing; neighbors were alerted to keep the "lung" breathing if electricity failed in a storm. Sybil would be in bed for life. Sybil said, timing her words to the "breathing" of the device, "that her faith gave her the courage to face each day."

Sybil has needed all the faith she could muster: Her husband died, not many years later, of a heart attack at work. Her mother came to live with the family, and, after caring for years, has died. The hardest grief came when Debbie's husband, a loving family man, died suddenly at 39, leaving Debbie with four school-age children to raise.

Sybil had gone to her daughter's wedding in an ambulance, with an orchid pinned to her shoulder and a bright ribbon in her dark hair.

It's a little better now: The "iron lung" is replaced by a lighter device. Sybil can hold a telephone and talk to friends. Daughter Debbie lives in a nearby town but Sybil's son, wife and children live in Colorado, coming home for short visits each summer.

Sybil, now 65, has a cheery smile and strong hand clasp. She worries, yes. That her state of Massachusetts will cut off her funds,, that her generator will cease to work in a power out-age, that an aide might not show up in an emergency, but there is much laughter in that house as Sybil keeps up with her grandchildren's doings. (Recently she shocked her oldest grandson when she knew the words to a rock song, learned because she likes to relate to the young people who come into to see her.)

Can there be such courage? Maybe it's not stretching imagination too far to think of Sybil Mattson and some few like her as a Pilgrim maiden and mother!!!"

OUR CLEARWATER BOYS AND POLLUTION



Many of our Clearwater boys who are card-holders in our Library, and who use our reference section to get information needed to get the Merit Badges required for the Lifesaving and Swimming Merit badges needed for the prestigious EAGLE SCOUT AWARD, are wishing that one great obstacle could be removed keeping them from obtaining Scouting's highest achievement.

For over 60 years our Clearwater Scouts have passed these and other outdoor required merit badges at nearby Camp Soule, located on the shores of the once pleasant Lake Chautauqua, south of Enterprise Road, between U.S. 19 and McMullen Booth Road.

Now, alas, the Scouts cannot swim in the lake because of pollution coming from septic tanks belonging to the many homes in the area. The owners of these homes, who are aware of the serious problem, would like to give up their septic tanks and hook into the Clearwater's sewer system. But these homes are outside Clearwater's city limit and the owners do not want to annex into the city.

The Clearwater Boy Scouts are hoping that the County and the City of Clearwater can find some solution to the problem, so that the beloved lake where their fathers and grandfathers swam can be made safe for them to resume their aquatic Scouting requirements.



RECORDING OF FAMILY DATA

By Geraldine Soule Schlosser, Soule Kindred Historian

One of the objectives of Soule Kindred is the gathering of information pertaining to the descendants of Pilgrim George Soule. Mayflower Families 3 covers the first 5 generations, to about 1800. Our families did a lot of moving around in the 19th century, and you can help locate migration patterns for family groups. That is why the Family Data Chart is printed in each issue of the Newsletter. Our historian may be able to help you with that "missing link". So please keep the information coming.

We would like to suggest that you begin with your sixth generation ancestor from George Soule (or your earliest Soule ancestor, if you haven't made the connection to George¹). Fill out a form for that ancestor, and then submit forms for each of your ancestors down to yourself. This is especially important if you descend through a female line; Soule women who marry tend to become lost Soules.

We'll give a short explanation of how to fill out the form. Samples were printed in V. 20, #2 and #3-- April and July, if you'd like to refer to those.

(1) The "Generation" space in the upper left corner shows the generation from the immigrant ancestor. Please leave it blank unless you are certain.

(2) In the far upper space on the right for "FAMILY", leave it blank if the surname of "Soule Descendant" is SOULE, SOWLE, or variants, because we'll assign a code number for closely related family groups. If the "Soule Descendant" has a different surname, insert the name in the right upper space.

(3) The next two lines show the ancestors of the "Soule Descendant" back to George Soule¹. Unless you have an approved Mayflower Lineage or other positive proof, we suggest this be left blank.

(4) When writing dates, follow the genealogical style-- first the day in numbers, then the month in letters, and the full year, such as 6 Feb 1833.

(5) When listing children on the reverse side, put in as much information as you can-- such as spouse's parents, if known.

(6) List your name and address as compiler unless someone else gathers the information. We may need to contact the compiler.

(7) It is VERY important to list sources of data; if the information comes from a family Bible or other record, a photocopy of the information should be included. Other sources, such as Vital Records from towns or states, and census should be indicated.

(8) Leave "Verification" blank for our purposes.

(9) Please give as many clues as possible to facilitate further research. If you are uncertain about a date, enter it, but add "circa" or "ca". For questionable place names, add "possibly" or "probably".

"It was a 13 1/2 hour trip from Orlando, Florida to Lilongwe, the capitol of Malawi. I still had a 40 minute trip by plane to Conforzi Tea Estate air strip. The terrain is rolling with scattered small villages, groves of gum (Eucalyptus) trees and large tea estates. The houses are simple ranch style made with brick on concrete floors, generally with no carpets. The floors are colored red and are waxed with a red wax. All windows have burglar bars because stealing seems to be a way of life here. The Malawians are generally small people. They are poor but friendly and have lots of children.

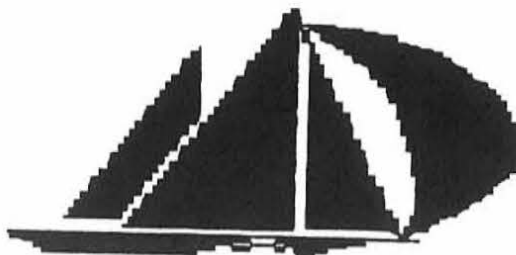
The hospital is nice for a rural mission hospital. There are about 200 beds but due to the dry season we are not full. It seems that about 50% of admissions are AIDS or AIDS related."

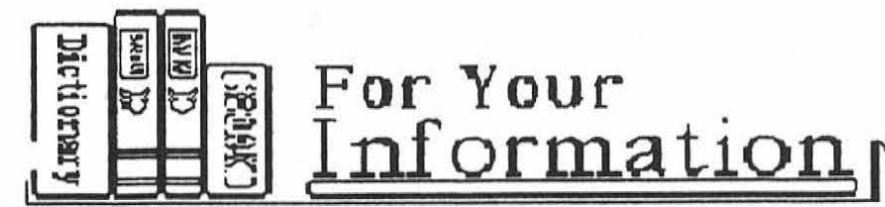

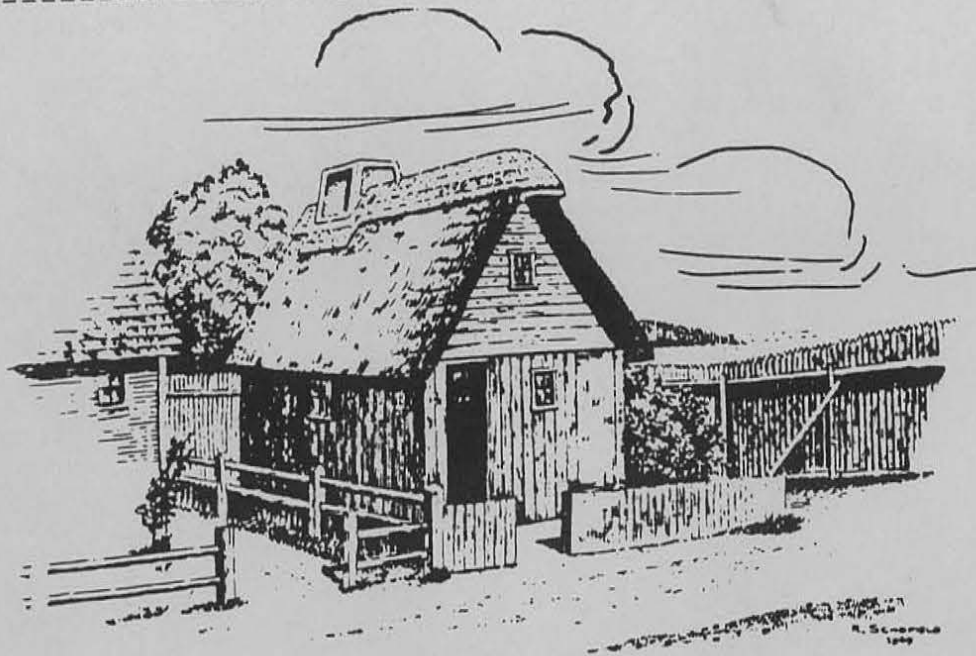
