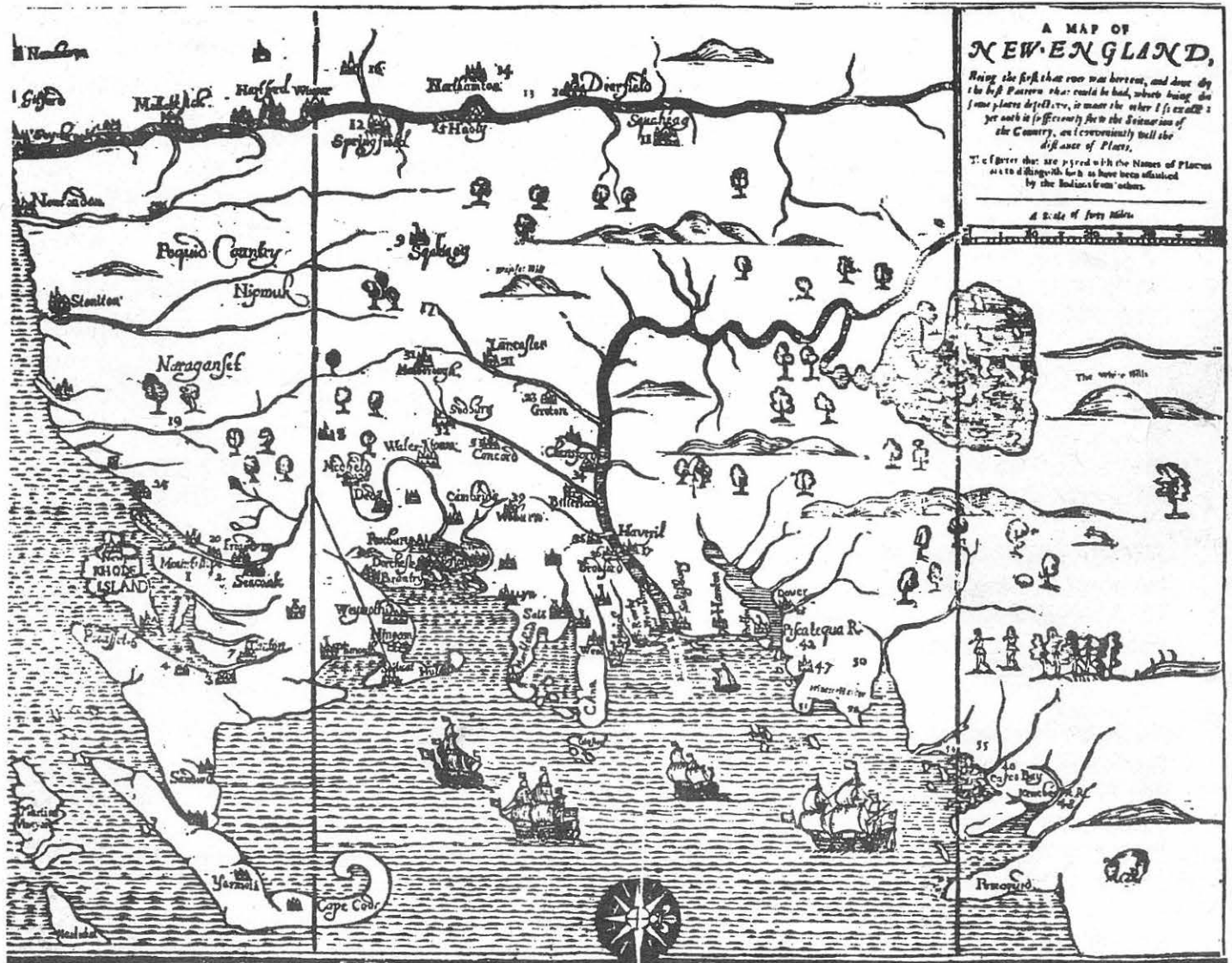

Yea, let them which have been redeemed of the Lord, shew how he hath delivered them from the hand of the oppressour. When they wandered in the deserte [and] wildernes out of the way, and found no cite to dwell in, both hungrie, and thirstie, their soule was overwhelmed in them. ## Taxing Affairs

Many colonial tax lists are as detailed as the inventory of a decedent's estate. Owners of real estate and personal property, as well as eligible voters, appear on tax rolls, often making it possible to find ancestors in these records when they appear nowhere else. Tax records, thought to excite only accountants and lawyers, may reveal helpful tidbits about your ancestors' lives. Imagine finding that an ancestor was wealthy enough to afford a four-wheel carriage, riding chair or pianoforte, or confirming that your great-great-grandfather owned the gold watch that has been passed down through the family.

To establish family connections, both genealogists and historians use tax lists. The demographics gleaned from a series of lists can be a gold mine. The presence of a name on a list confirms that a person was in a particular locality at a specific time, indicates lifestyle, and reveals neighbors.

Records are used to solve such genealogical research problems as tracing a family from place to place and finding clues to relationships that resulted from inheritances. Tax lists also are invaluable for sorting out men of the same name, as they often are referred to by appearance, a nickname, their occupation, where they lived, or by ethnic origin. Entries such as John Miller Blacksmith, or John Smith Elk Creek, are often found in the records.

Throughout the United States, taxes were levied as early as 1782 on both real estate and personal property, at both the state and county or town levels. In New England, tax rolls were kept by the towns, while in other parts of the country the county was responsible for collections and maintenance of the lists. Records for land included the number of acres owned and a detailed description of location and boundaries. Personal property taxes were assessed on items including livestock, carriages, and slaves. So even if your ancestor did not own land, he probably owned a horse, and it is in these records that an ancestor may be mentioned.

Unless they were widows or the sole heads of a household, women were usually left off the early tax rolls. Widows and heirs of land are shown as the taxpayers on their inherited properties. Laws gave a widow a one-third interest in the property of her deceased husband. Because of this, a widow was often taxed on one third of the property and her sons on equal amounts to make up the other two-thirds of the estate, thus providing clues of family links. (This rule usually did not apply to daughters.)

In addition, a head, or poll, tax was commonly levied by each county on white males 16 to 21 years of age and older. It was levied without reference to property. Often, a tax on every slave or servant above age 16 also was paid by the person or by the parent or guardian of eligible persons. These records can be helpful in sorting out the sons in a family.

It is also possible to trace ancestors to the Colonial period by quit-rent rolls and tithables. Quit-rent taxes, which were amounts paid yearly by landowners generally at a rate per 100 acres of land, were abolished at the start of the Revolution.

Adult males sometimes paid a tithe, usually a small fraction of the estimated value of their possessions, to support churches and ministers. It was assessed by ownership of acreage, livestock, and other holdings. In most cases, early tax records are collected by state libraries or archives of the original colonies. Sometimes, tax records are still held by the local taxing unit. Armed with information abstracted from tax records, it is possible to solve some challenging genealogical problems. The census taker may have missed your ancestors, but the tax man seldom did.

## Well! Bless My Soule

Perhaps enough has been said about how George "Pilgrim" Soule probably pronounced his name. However, in light of the critique of the article *How Do You Pronounce Soule, Sowle, Soule, Etc?* by this author,<sup>2</sup> entitled *How Do You Pronounce Soule? Another Opinion* by Marion E. Harrison,<sup>3</sup> a few points need to be clarified.

Mr. Harrison contends that, "pronunciation of a family name by a child does not prove how the parent pronounced it." Robert C. Thompson, Arizona Historian, reminds us that George "Pilgrim" Soule's will includes the statement, "*-I commit my Soule into the hands of Almighty God-*," similar to that in George II's will, "*my soule unto God who gave it.*" In addition in John (older brother of George II) Soule's will he spells his name as Soul.

The second point made by Mr. Harrison was that we don't know how George II pronounced "soul" and that perhaps he didn't spell well or didn't proof well. These may be true but they are weak arguments in support of his position.

The last point was in regard to the accent mark on the tombstone inscriptions of Jonathan Soule and Peter Soule that I pointed out in the original article. This marker was believed to have been placed there by Margaret, daughter of Jonathan. Perhaps the same argument could be made that it was a typo.

When I was young, my grandfather, Peter Lee Potter, son of Jerusha Jane Soule and Sylvester Potter, bored me to death with stories of our ancestors out of his little black book. (What I wouldn't give for that little black book now!) He always pronounced the name "soul."

I repeat "- in reference to George "Pilgrim" Soule, it should always be pronounced **soul**."

## Desktop Descendants

Today's computer oriented genealogists are facing many problems that pioneer computer genealogists had. CD-ROM producers and vendors have catered to the mass market, overlooking the special needs and wishes of this hobby. However, every field has its specialized providers, and genealogy is no exception. Slowly but surely, more genealogical and historical CDs are being offered. And, as technology opens new doors and windows, as the case may be, genealogists are discovering new research opportunities--some via modem, some on the Internet and on-line services.

Among the first CD-ROMs to hit the market are census indices and marriage records. Most of the 1850 census indices are now produced by Broderbund Software and are available from genealogical vendors and software stores. Many 1860 and 1870 census indices for various locales, including the 1870 census index for New York City, are offered by AGL (American Genealogical Lending Library, P.O. Box 244, Bountiful, UT 84011-0244). Compiled statewide marriage CDs are a mixed bag, with some data overlapping on some of the discs. Louisiana, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, Maryland, North Carolina, Virginia, Arkansas, Missouri, Mississippi, and Texas are represented, but these are mostly early (pre-1850, in most instances) marriage records. No comprehensive compilations of all marriages in every county for any particular state for all years is available yet.

Other records on CD include pre-1790 census indices, the 1790 U.S. census index, and various other early (1800-40) census indices. Federal land records for Arkansas, Florida, and Louisiana are available on CD from the Bureau of Land Management (703-440-1600). Also on CD are the Social Security Death Index, 1850-80 mortality records, along with sundry local phone directories, and courthouse directories. AniMap's excellent county mapping programs are sold by Gold bug (510-838-MAPS).

Other pedigree-type databases are available for CD-ROM. In the hands of experienced researchers, they can be useful aids, but novices may accept such linked pedigrees without question or independent verification, adding to the plethora of false pedigrees that find their way into family histories.

One specialized, but outstanding CD is the "Indian Question" by Objective Computing (317-475-9904). Hopefully, it is representative of CDs to come. It contains approximately 10,000 pages of federal documents, maps, and photographs. It also includes all treaties the United States made with American Indian tribes. Not only of interest to genealogists researching Native American lines, it is helpful to students and social historians.

In addition to basic lineage-linked database software on disc, there are also county boundary historical atlases, book indexing software, and deed mapping programs. Numerous genealogy software programs can help you keep track of your ancestors and compile your research into neat formats and charts. Brother's Keeper, Family Roots, Visual Roots, MacRoots, and Personal Ancestral File are just a few.

Despite rumors, you cannot go online and connect with a giant computer at the vast Family History Library (FHL) in Salt Lake City, Utah, and download your family's history. It is doubtful that the FHL will ever offer such a service, and even if it does, you will have to do the basic research on your families in order to make valid connections. Similarly, there is no on-line access to the records of the National Archives and Library of Congress.

Access to the Internet and its graphical interface, the World Wide Web, can be gained through on-line services--Prodigy (800-PRODIGY), CompuServe (800-848-8199), America Online (800-827-6364), and GENie (800-638-9636), among others--and through local providers. The commercial services all have active genealogy bulletin boards affording customers advice on how to locate data--and perhaps even the opportunity of finding cousins to exchange information with.

Caught in the web of the Internet are some exciting opportunities. Already, there are hundreds, perhaps thousands, of sites--as they are called--pertaining to genealogy. One of the most interesting is the Civil War Center, where one can find images, songs, letters, diaries, battlefield information, cemeteries, re-enactment's, and information about the units that served from many states. Also available is a photograph database, where you may just find an ancestor's name and pull up a photograph of that relative on screen. If you've ever wondered if your ancestor fought at the Alamo, a list of those who fell in that 1836 battle is available on-line. There are also sites up or under construction that can help you trace your Italian, Swedish, German, Jewish, or eastern European ancestors. For more information about Internet access and offerings, check with your local genealogical societies. Many have computer-interest groups that are up-to-date on the Internet and providers in your area.

Electronic genealogy is still in its infancy, and there is no doubt that evolving on-line research services and CDs will continue to be in demand as genealogists become more adept at utilizing their computers and modems to find their roots. Cyberspace has plenty of room for genealogical pioneers.



## Auto dealer leaves collection of carriages

NORTH YARMOUTH, Maine (AP) — Auto dealer Horace "Ken" Sowles collected the vehicles his line of business had made obsolete — and amassed one of the nation's largest collections of horse-drawn carriages.

At his death last month at age 77, he left some 300 milk wagons, stage coaches, sleighs, shays, hotel stages and breaks.

Sowles, of Falmouth and North Yarmouth, willed most of them to a museum he founded, the Carriage Museum of America, in Bird-in-Hand, Pa.

The collection includes a wicker two-wheeler from the late 1700s, a small sleigh, known as an Albany cutter, once owned by President John Quincy Adams and a 19th-century open carriage built for trips to the race track.

Rather than treat his car-

riages as precious museum objects, he drove several, hitching them up to the horses he kept on the farm and taking his three sons for rides.

"Ken was collecting carriages at a time when people were trying to just get them out of their barn because they were taking up

space," said Susan Green, museum librarian.

Carriage collectors are a small group whose members include Prince Philip of England. The Carriage Association of America, another organization Sowles founded, claims about 3,000 members.

## E-MAIL

Here begins a new section in the newsletter for which I would welcome any suggestions. This section contains Internet e-mail received from members and their e-mail addresses. Each issue I'll publish pertinent messages received since the last issue. The message(s) might be edited if necessary for brevity and/or clarity.

The end of this section contains a current e-mail address list and the respective lineage that the person is researching, if applicable. In the event I don't receive any e-mail messages since the previous issue (highly unlikely, I hope) just the address list will be printed. Addresses for a *Soule Kindred* officers (where applicable) also appear inside the front cover under their name.

The following is an informative article I came across on the subject of "netiquette", that is, tips, shortcuts, etc., for your e-mail or your postings to a newsgroup on the Internet.

- When posting a news article, remember that what you say might be posted worldwide. State your opinions carefully and explain that they are yours and nobody else's. But, if you're still offending people, try deodorant.
- Don't go looking for arguments or you'll wind up in what net-surfers call "flame-wars." "Flame-wars" sounds like the latest video game, but they are really just insult matches. - When visiting a newsgroup for the first time, be sure to check out an article called the "FAQ," which means "Frequently Asked Questions." It will help you avoid posting a question that has already been asked and answered a million times.
- Using net-surf abbreviations not only lets people know you're net-wise, it helps you type a lot faster (*type faster? How about say more in less space?*). Try sprinkling a few of these in your next post.

SOULE KINDRED INDEXES AVAILABLE

A third index has been completed for about 1,000 persons who are descendants but do not have the name Soule or other spelling variations. This Surname Index was created primarily from lineage's submitted recently by members of Soule Kindred. It should be used with our earlier indexes and the 1992 supplement published in the 1992 Soule Kindred Newsletter Summer edition (Volume XXVI, No. 3).

Also available are copies of the original index created by Dr. Milton Terry listing more than 7,000 individuals with the name Soule, including codes for the source of information and a numbering system for tracing lineage of many individuals. That index includes the names of the spouse of about 5,000 of the individuals.

Those spouse names have been indexed in alphabetic order with name and code number of the individual in the original Terry index. However, you must have the Terry index to use the spouse index.

The cost of each of the three indexes is a standard \$ 10.00, including mailing. They are printed on 8 1/2 by 11 inch paper.

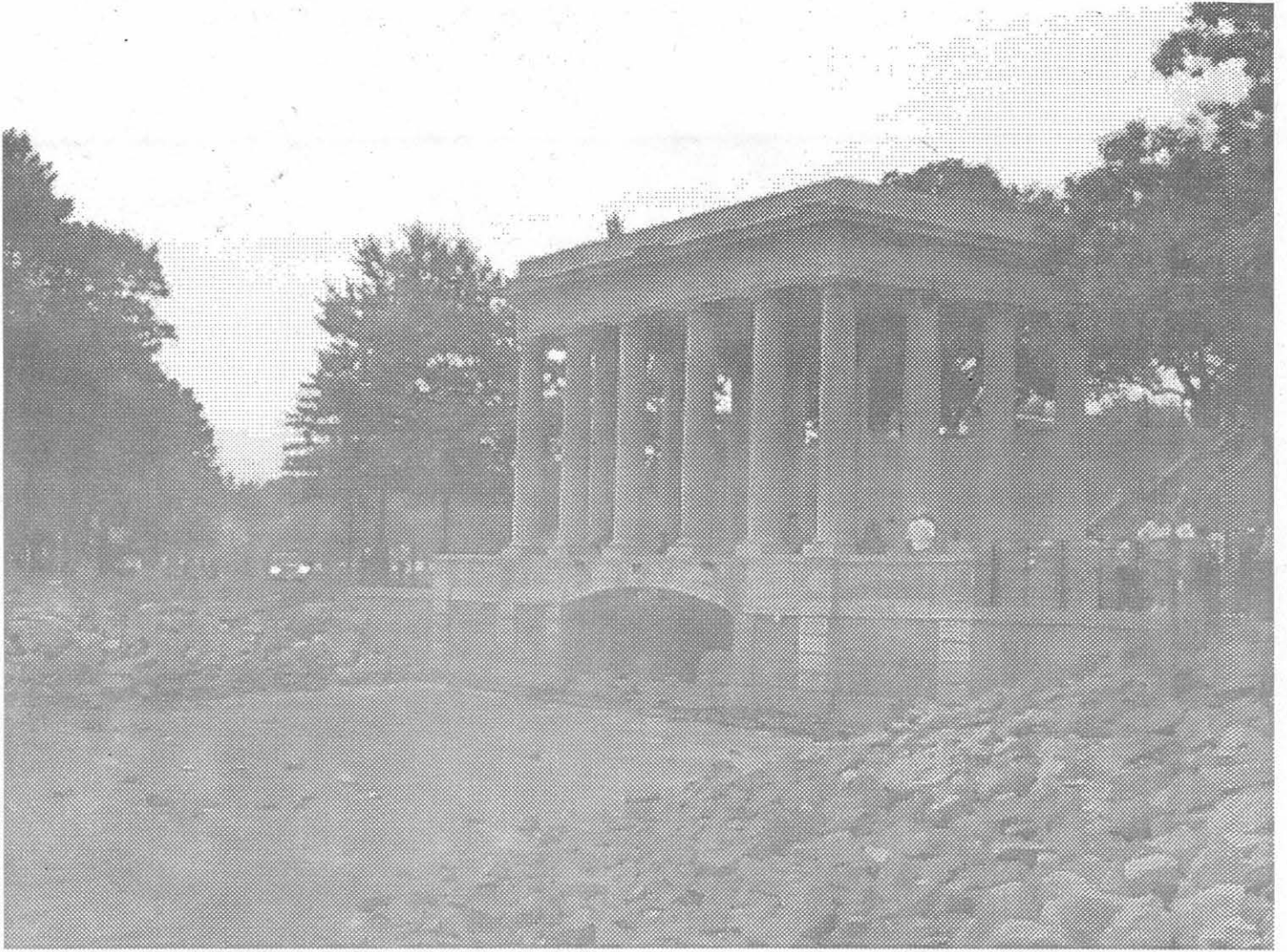
