Reunion 2001

Elsewhere in this Newsletter is a Pre-Registration page for our 2001 Reunion and annual meeting in the Blue Ridge Mountains, with headquarters in Hendersonville, NC June 27-July 1.

Reunion Extras

Two sideshows are planned for the 2001 Reunion.

Two Kodak Carousels of slides on Soule and Pilgrim history and photos from early reunions were put together perhaps 20 years ago and shown at a number of subsequent Reunions. They were recently found but no narration was included. They will be shown at free times during the Reunion. Our hope is that long-time members present will remember what was explained during the slide sequence, and identify members photographed.

Second, we will experiment with offering genealogical search advice to members who wish it. Sign-up sheets will be collected at registration for both folks who need advice on conventional or internet searches and experienced members willing to share their knowledge. Depending on the extent of such interest, either small groups or paired individuals will be arranged for free time or bus rides.

At our business meeting, opinion will be sought on whether the coming Reunion in Plymouth should be scheduled at the same time as the Triennial meeting of the Mayflower Society, or just before or after, or at an unrelated time. A Kindred meeting simultaneously or adjacent to the Mayflower meeting gives an opportunity for participation in both. A Kindred meeting separately timed avoids crowding in use of the Mayflower Library, visits to Plimoth Plantation, the ship Mayflower, overnight and banquet facilities, and other tourist functions.

Membership in 2001

Seventeen descendants of George Soule have joined the Kindred in the first quarter of 2001. Five of these are relatives of other members. Three were referred by the Mayflower Society and nine applied through the Kindred Website. Hopefully, continuation of this membership trend will offset the 48 members who have not responded to our January renewal appeal.

100 Living Life Members

Three new Life Members in 2001 bring the total such supporters of our scholarship fund to 100. They are: Wayne A. Patterson of Attica, Michigan, Frank Flint Soule III of Palatine, Illinois, a Kindred Director, and Louise Walsh Throop of Sunol, California, editor of the fifth and sixth generation books on George Soule descendants in the Mayflower Families In Process series.

Our Website

Ruth Hall reports that there have been 152 visitors to our Rootsweb address on the internet. Its long address is printed at the top of the inside front cover of this Newsletter. Ruth also maintains an identical back-up SKA website in the Geocities system.

New Soule Genealogy Books

Dorothy Soule of Brockton, MA reports that she purchased the two new Mayflower Society books on descendants of George Soule and "found them very helpful." She also called to my attention an error in the zip code for orders in the January Newsletter. Copies may be purchased from Mayflower Families, P.O. Box 3297, Plymouth, MA 02361. The new publications are (1) A third edition tracing the first four generations of descendants of George Soule (cost \$8 plus \$3 shipping) and (2) The first of a projected six volumes tracing the fifth and sixth generations focuses on descendants of George's first son Jonathan (cost \$10 plus \$3 shipping).

The Kindred Board of Directors authorized a \$1,000 initial contribution for support of this research from the bequest to Soule Kindred of Col. John E. Soule "to continue research and publication of the genealogical history of the Soule family based on my own lifetime research." Further financial support will be considered by the Board at its June 30 meeting.

The annual report of the Mayflower Five Generations Project published in the December 2000 Mayflower Quarterly notes that Soule Kindred is also "cooperating, giving us reels and reels of research that was never analyzed."

Our Member, Louise Walsh Throop, editor of the series, reports that the next pink book should be published this summer, probably in August, with the third pink book planned for the summer of 2002. The first three pink books are to cover all of the fifth and sixth generation Soule-named descendants of the sons of George Soule

of the Mayflower. The last three pink books will cover the daughters' descendants (the un-Soule families).

Kindred Index Digitized

Kindred Historian Charles "Jack" Sowles reports digitization completed of the Soule Kindred Index, Spouse's Index, and Soule - Other Surname Indexes, which have been a primary research source for Soule family lineage. In conjunction with the archival files of the Soule Kindred in America they form a large resource database that was made available to Soule Family genealogical researchers in pamphlet form. The next step will be production of this data on a readable compact disk.

Questions have arisen about the content of these Soule Kindred Indexes and their origin. These tables summarize the published research of numerous authors of Soule Family genealogy including the General Society of Mayflower Descendants; G. T. Ridlon's Soule genealogy; research efforts of several Soule Kindred In America Historians; by numerous individual members of Soule Kindred In America; and other private Soule researchers here acknowledged.

Some have questioned the reliability and accuracy of these indices, and admittedly, just as in all printed matter of such publications as this database, they are subject to discrepancies in interpretation of source material, Jack says.

As an overall evaluation of the Soule Kindred Indexes, Jack has used them extensively and found them highly effective for the beginning research "leads" required when starting any new family research project.

They summarize, in tabular form, over 7500 individual Soule family members' names, that can then be assembled into lineage charts -- most of which derive generationally backward to the original Mayflower Passenger George Soule.

An advantage of the use of these tables is easy upgradability, allowing for additions and corrections as research into George Soule's descendent lines progresses. There have been several correction/addition supplements published in the past.

Besides speed in computer manipulation of large files such as these, there is a second advantage to these computerized files. Even moderately adept computer users may now easily do a backward generational search to determine name and ancestral number of a parent alphabetically; then do a numerical search to determine all the sons and daughters of that parent. This feature was conceivable in the original indices, but not very practicable, since it entailed a visual search for numbers through 135 pages of printed columns.

All previously published correction/addition supplements including a new supplement for the millennium have been incorporated into this CD-ROM Version of the Soule Kindred Indexes. Future plans are that there will be at least a biennial correction/addition supplement for CD-ROM upgrades. There will be corresponding hard copy upgrades made available at the same time.

Agenda:

Wednesday June 27th: Arrivals and check in.

Our Hospitality Room is The Four Seasons Room located just off the main lobby. The room will be available from 10am and throughout the day and evening.

Thursday, June 28th: Our bus will leave the Quality Inn at 9am for our short journey to the Biltmore Estate, the grand 8,000 acre estate built by George Vanderbilt. There, we will tour the mansion, visit shops, stroll through the gardens and enjoy the winery. Lunch will be "on our own". The choices range from a Hot Dog Cart in the Stable Court Yard to a generous buffet at the Deerpark Restaurant. There are three restaurants in all on the estate.

After leaving the Biltmore Estate, we will return to Hendersonville via the Blue Ridge Parkway that offers some spectacular views of the Blue Ridge Mountains. We will be passing near the North Carolina Arboretum and the Folk Art Center and if there is any interest and energy left, we can stop for a visit. If not, these would be great places to visit on our free Saturday.

Friday, June 29th: We will leave the Quality Inn at 10am in carpools for the 20 minute ride to Chimney Rock Park and the Village of Chimney Rock. We will drive to the base of the natural formation and take an elevator to the Sky Lounge which contains a snack bar, gift shop and offers lovely views.

Thomas Russell Johnston, 52, of North Granby, formerly of Winsted, beloved husband of Barbara (Lyon) Johnston died Sunday (January 28, 2001) in a hang glider accident.

Born in Washington D.C., son of Patricia (Mullen) Johnston of Frederick, MD, and the late Fred R. Johnston, he grew up in Rockville, MD and graduated from Robert E. Perry High School and the University of Cincinnati Engineering School in 1972.

He lived in Winsted for ten years moving to North Granby 14 years ago. He was employed as an aerospace engineer at Hamilton Standard for 22 years before starting his own engineering business Data Solutions.

The two loves of Tom's life, family and flying, brought him challenges, joy and fulfillment. He was a hang gliding pilot for 25 years and also had his private aircraft pilot's license. He was a member of the Soaring Society of America, the U.S. Hang Gliding Association, Connecticut Hang Gliding Association, and the Nutmeg Soaring Society.

Besides his wife and mother he leaves his beloved children, Kara E. The Honorable Thomas Gene Kenyon, 73, of Granite Shoals, Texas, died on June 7, 2000.

He is survived by his wife of over 50 years, Colleen Moore Kenyon; his daughter, Karen Lynne Kenyon, granddaughter, Stephanie Michelle Hickman and great-grandson, Michael Eric Thomas Farmley; his son, Torry Frazier Kenyon, daughter-in-law, Kitty Kooos Kenyon, granddaughter, Kelly Marie Kenyon and grandson, Carl Frazier Kenyon.

Tom and Colleen Kenyon lived in the Brazosport area, Brazoria County, Texas for 30 years before moving to Granite Shoals, Burnet County, Texas in 1992.

Judge Kenyon was born February 7, 1927, in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. His parents were William A. Kenyon and Beulah May Hopper Kenyon. He graduated from Lawton Oklahoma High School in 1944, and served in the U.S. Army 1945 - 1946. He attended the University of Oklahoma and SMU, obtaining his law degree from SMU in 1951. From 1951 - 1953, he was in the U.S. Air Force, Office of Special Investigation. He also graduated from the First Texas College of the Judiciary in 1974. Judge Kenyon was admitted to the Texas Bar in 1951, and was in the private practice of law for 14 years, including serving as City Attorney for Clute, Texas, 1958-62 and City Judge of Freeport, Texas, 1959-62. He was elected Criminal District Attorney, Brazoria County, Texas where he served 1963-66. In 1970, he was the President of the Brazoria County Bar Association. He was appointed Judge of the Court of Domestic Relations in Brazoria County Texas in 1973. This court became the 300th Judicial District Court and he served in that capacity until his retirement in 1986, hearing primarily domestic relations and criminal cases.

During his tenure as a Judge, he served as Chairman of the Juvenile Court Judges Committee, Judicial Section, State Bar of Texas, in 1978. After retiring from the 300th Judicial Court, he served as a Senior District Judge, State of Texas, 1987 - 1998, working on assignments in various District Courts throughout Texas.

Among other activities, Judge Kenyon was a member of the Velasco, Texas, Jaycees; Commander of the Raiph Hanson Post, American Legion, Freeport, Texas; Commander U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, Flotilla 64, Freeport, Texas; Board of Regents, Brazosport Community College; Board of Regents, Texas Chiropractic College; President, Freeport Little League; President, Brazosport Quarterback Club; President, Kingsland Genealogical Society; Volunteer, Kingsland Library, Genealogy Section. He took greatest pride in his role as Founding Member, President and Chairman of the Board of Brazoria County Youth Homes, a home for abandoned, abused and neglected children.

Among his many awards and honors were the DAR Medal of Honor, The SAR Law Enforcement Commendation Medal, the UDC Cross of Military Service, The Texas State Teachers Association Special Certificate of Appreciation, The Texas Historical Commission Citation for Distinguished Service, and the Ramsey Jaycees Distinguished Service Award.

Judge Kenyon was active in genealogy research and was a member of the Sons of the American Revolution, Sons of the Republic of Texas, Sons of the Confederate Veterans, Huguenot Society of Texas, National Huguenot Society, Order of Founders and Patriots of America, the General Society of Mayflower Descendants, the Austin Colony, Society of Mayflower Descendants in the State of Texas, First Families of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, First Families of the Twin Territories of Oklahoma, Somerset Chapter, Magna Charta Barons, Colonial Order of the Crown, Order of Washington.

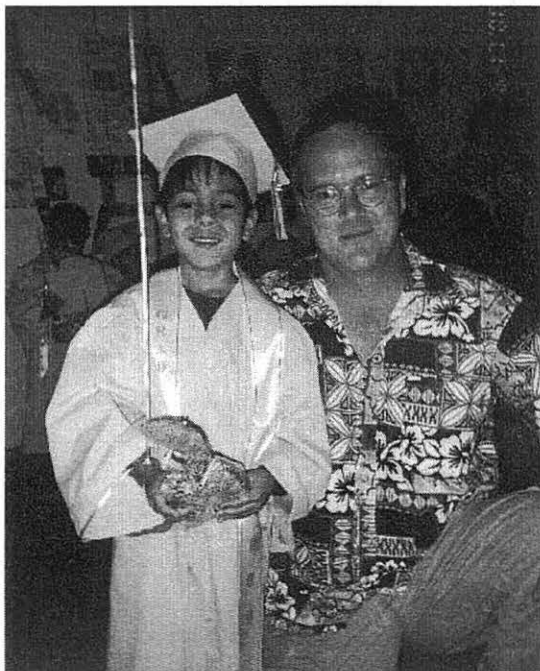



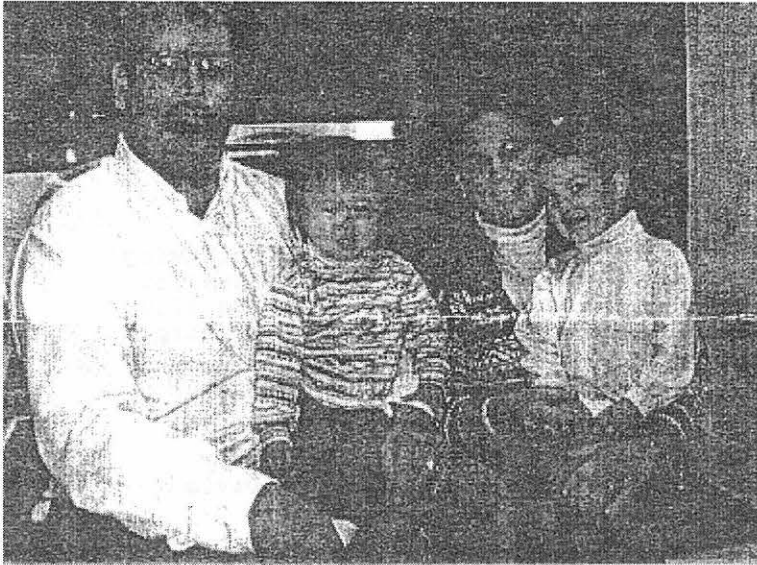

Good Morning listers. The list has been quiet of late. I am looking to discuss the Rowland Soule/Soles problem. As many know there were several "Rowlands" and it is confusing. I know I am not alone in the confusion as I have heard from others over the years.

I believe Rowland Soule 1733-1791? to be my weak link. I am descended through his son William born in 1789 possibly Duanesburg, NY. I have recently come to the conclusion that he was a Royalist/Tory during the Revolution and left NY at the end of the war and changed his last name to "Soles". My "William" was always known as "Soles" (consistently in census records.) and his son

John changed it back to Soule. The 1790 Census finds him in St. Albans, VT without wife and family. If anyone researching "United Empire Loyalists" has any supporting evidence I would appreciate the information. I am still collecting Soule Census data to be used for your queries and if you have family members listed (1850 and up) I like to list them as well. We all know how hard it is to track and trace female ancestors.

I am always willing to share what I have, but am getting concerned about the erroneous information now being posted on "Gedcoms". I try to verify as much of my information as I can with actual records such as Census, deeds, wills and death certificates.

Hello again, Soule listers--I recently posted a note to you all mentioning a Stephen P. Soule I had found in 1855 Wisconsin, while pursuing other current lines. I have been receiving responses to me personally instead of to Soule-L, some with rather an amazing number of requests for more information, more names, lookups, etc. In an effort to forestall these, I am replying to you all (which I believe is the correct forum to use as a response). I found my information in an online data base for the state of Wisconsin, accessible through the Wisconsin Local History Network. For those of you who are interested in Wisconsin ancestors, I suggest you do some surfing through the WLHN series of pages. Excellent historical background, some cemetery records, censuses, etc.

I am a descendant of a Soule from Maine who went to Wisconsin (Polly, married Stephen Philbrick FOLSOM), and I believe I have her family pretty well in hand. Polly was the daughter of Joseph Soule and Mary DARLING, and had two brothers, Joshua and Joseph (good old Soule names). The brothers also moved to Wisconsin. The families for all three are covered in Ridlon's book. The information for Polly's family has some errors, as all such books seem to have, but Ridlon pointed me to the primary sources and that's all one can expect. Polly also had six Maine half-brothers surnamed TOWLE, five of whom moved to Wisconsin as well.

My mention of Stephen P. Soule to the list was done just in case someone had mislaid him and had never seen the

Wisconsin State Census. To those of you who have emailed me directly, I do not have more information on him or his spouse, or his parents, or his children, nor am I seeking such information.

Hello, Soule Listers--Yesterday I copied this information from LDS microfilm roll 10428, the Avon, Maine Town Records. This is a curious document, with the town charter, road surveys, and town meeting minutes interspersed with marriages, marriage intents, and deaths. The records sometimes devote a separate page to record information for a particular family. In most cases, this information appeared to have been entered all at once, probably from private family information provided to the town clerk. The mention of a birth, marriage or death does _not_ mean the event took place in Avon.

One family record summarized in this way is that of Joshua SOULE and his wife Mary CUSHMAN. It may be of interest to some Soule researchers who have not seen the Avon records, so I have copied it out below. It should be noted that in some cases the dates given differ from those in Ridlon's book. The records are entered in a generally clear handwriting (possibly that of Joshua Soule himself, who was town clerk in Avon). Even so, there are a few cases where a date is uncertain. As far as I know, these are the only Avon "Vital Records" for this family.

Please note that this is _all_ the information I have. Also, I am not suggesting that Ridlon's book or some other town vital records are incorrect. But in the early 1800s someone in the family believed these dates were correct.
