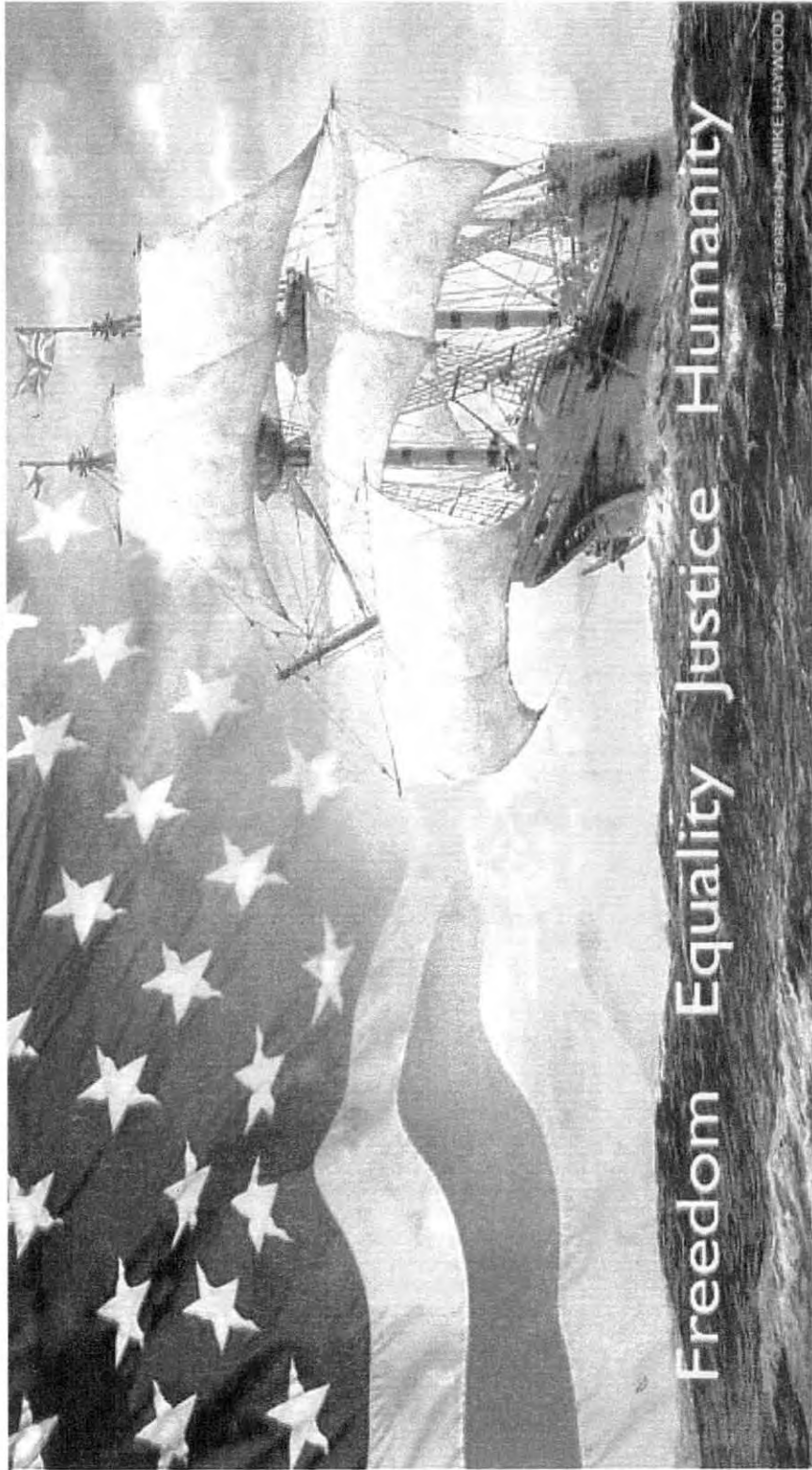

The Soule Kindred in America was formed in 1967 by a group of dedicated people who were interested in tracing their back to Pilgrim George Soule who arrived aboard the Mayflower in 1620. The Soule Kindred are dedicated to preserving and passing this important genealogical information onto anyone interested in tracing their ancestry.

The Soule Kindred is a non-profit organization incorporated in Massachusetts in 1972 with members in Europe, Canada and throughout the United States. Through the diligence of the first president George Soule, Colonel John Soule, both direct descendants of Pilgrim George Soule, a great heritage was found to have been left by our founding fathers.

Genealogical records are available through the Soule Kindred Historian to assist those interested in tracing their family roots. The Soule Kindred has microfilm records containing thousands of names and information back to Mayflower passenger George Soule. Through the quarterly Soule Kindred Newsletter genealogical information is contributed and distributed to our membership.

Activities of Soule Kindred include the annual Soule Kindred Reunion held in different cities. The Reunion provides a forum for the annual meeting, an opportunity to meet "cousins", exchange genealogy information and make lasting friendships. Some members maintain their own web sites while others communicate regularly via-mail.

There are no restrictions to joining Soule Kindred. Your name does not have to be Soule, Sole, Soules.Sowl, and Sowles or even begin with an "S". The only requirement is that you have an interest in determining and tracing your ancestry. If the idea of finding your roots and meeting new "cousins" appeals to you, we invite you to send in your application and join us.

There is one section for a Reuel Williams Soule of Augusta, Me who was Ex-United States Consul to Canada and veteran of the 28th Maine regiment in the Civil War.. He was a native of Phillips, Franklin County, Me. His stated line from George Soule is: George 1, John 2, Joshua 3, Joseph 4, Joshua 5, William 6, William, Jr 7, and Reuel being the eighth generation. There are 448 pages of information that might be useful to lines that married into the Soule families living in Maine in the 19th century.

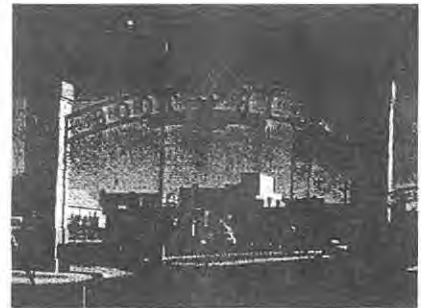

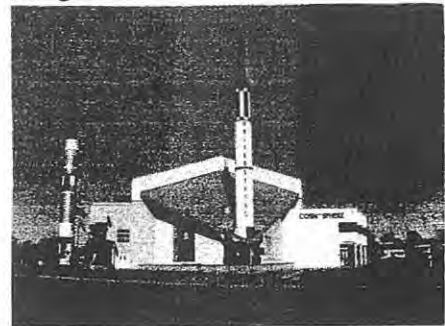

I look forward to having the Soule Kindred come and "Share Our Space" as we have a "Party on the Prairie" in Hutchinson, KS. A tentative schedule is included.

We will spend some time learning about the pioneers of the "Old West" as well as a "Soule connection" with Dodge City. To give you a bit of a teaser, Asa T. Soule left an impression on Dodge City. I say this literally and figuratively. He was instrumental in the Eureka Irrigation Company that was going to move water from the Arkansas River to help the farmers. The canal that was dug was known as the "Soule Ditch" or "Soule Folly".



We will also explore the Planets with a trip to the Kansas Cosmosphere and Space Center. The Cosmosphere is said to be second only to the Smithsonian in space artifacts. This day will include the museum, a planetarium show, an Omnimax show, and a visit to Dr. Goddard's Lab.

The Reunion Headquarters will be at the **Hampton Inn, 1401 ½ E 11th, Hutchinson, KS.** Reservations should be made through the hotel, not the national number to get the special rate. That number is **620-665-9800**. There is a block of rooms that will be held until May 22nd under Soule Kindred. Rates for 1-4 people are: King room—79.95 + tax; 2 Queen room--\$84.95 + tax.

They also have a few that are "family suites" and "Jacuzzi suites". The family is one room with 2 queen beds and a hide-a-bed. Other accommodations are available. RV hookups are available at the Kansas State Fair Grounds, 620-669-3600. There are other motels for which I can provide information.

Air Travel:

Mid-Continent Airport, Wichita Kansas is approximately 50 miles from Hutchinson. Wichita is served by AirTran, Allegiant, America West, American, Continental, Delta, Northwest, and United.

Salina Airport is 60 miles north of Hutchinson. It is served by a regional carrier of USAir.

Other possibilities are Kansas City, approximately 3 ½ -4 hours away and Oklahoma City, also 3 ½ to 4 hours.

A History of Soule Reunions

Editor's note: I asked Bertha to tell us about past Soule Reunions. I got so much more than I expected. This is a wonderful story about the memory of reunions. I hope it motivates many to attend the next Soule Kindred Reunion in Hutchinson, KS

Dear Cousin Bill:

I am not sure what I'm going to write about but I will try.

My lineage is I George (the pilgrim): II George, III William, IV George, V George, VI Joseph, VII Gilbert Randell, VIII Freeman Gilbert, IX Freeman Wilber, X Me & my 15 brothers and sisters.

I have not attended every reunion since 1969. My first one was 1980 in Waco, Texas. There were 6 of us kids plus our Mother and 5 of her grand kids. It was due to me that we were all there. I had learned about the Kindred Organization and joined in 1967 but I was on the faculty of our local high school and during summer months was busy with garden, helping on the ranch and being a leader in our 4-H club.

We all had a great time in Waco but I'm the only one of the family who has continued my membership all these years. I have tried to report to the Kindred births, deaths, marriages etc. but I was not able to attend another Reunion until 1997 in Madison, Indiana. I was caring for various family members during that time.

I convinced 2 of my sisters (Betty & Phyllis) and my daughter Christine to go with me. Another good time.

In 1999 the Reunion was held in Landmark, Ill. Christine Hill, my daughter, sisters Phyllis Enos and Joan Talkington joined me. This is one I did not want to miss as my Great Grandfather (Gilbert Randell Soule) left New York with two brothers and settled in Michigan before moving on to Illinois. They were farmers. In Illinois he married Ester Phidelia Freeman. He moved to Galena. His wife died in Galena and is buried there. While we were in that area we checked every source we could and toured all the cemeteries searching for Ester Phidelia's grave. Unfortunately, we never found it. Gilbert Randell left Illinois with his five children and headed for Kansas. The children were Freeman Gilbert (our Grandfather), George Alonzo, Orthia Fidelia, Adaline Jane and Marcia Eliza. He homesteaded just west of what is now known as Olpe, Kansas. It was here my Grandfather (Freeman Gilbert) grew up. He raised his family here. My Father, Freeman Wilber was the seventh of ten children.

My Father donated a corner of the homestead for the Olpe Cemetery, where he and several members of the family are buried. The house the family lived in is still there and is inhabited. I have never been in it as it changed owners before my time. When my Father and his siblings grew up their place was where the stage coach from Emporia to Chicago stopped and changes horses and drivers. In early 1900's Freeman Gilbert disposed of the homestead and moved with his youngest, daughter, Lulu Adeline and farmed for a short time in Meade County until the grasshoppers wiped them out. They returned to Madison, Ks where he spent the remainder of his life.

The 2000 reunion was held in Ventura, California. My daughter Christine Hill and granddaughter Judy Hill and I attended. Judy was in Washington State doing research relate to college courses, so it was convenient for her to meet us there.

The 2001 Reunion was held in Hendersonville, North Carolina. Judy, Christine and I enjoyed touring the area. It was very scenic, especially the Biltmore Estate, the Blue Ridge Mountains and Chimney Rock.

The 2002 Reunion was held in Mystic, Connecticut. Judy, Christine Hill, Judy Thole and I enjoyed a riverboat ride, toured the submarine museum and visited Plimouth Plantation.

The 2003 reunion was in San Antonio, Texas. Judy, Christine, Judy and I had an interesting trip. We toured the home of President Johnson enroute and later visited the Alamo, Mission San Jose, Tower of America, Spanish Governor's House and Sea World.

In July 2004, we had a "spur of the moment" get together when my brother Merle, his daughter Gwen and family were in Town from Illinois. My brothers and sisters all met at City Park with a covered dish. Success! Twelve of 14 showed up for a total of 65. Now we were ready to go to the 2004 Reunion in Ottawa. My sister Susan Thole, Joan Talkington, my daughter Christine Hill, and her daughter Judy and I attended. We enjoyed the beautiful scenery, a boat ride up the Ottawa River and new experience, the changing of the guard at Parliament Hill.

Lastly, I thought you might enjoy of few pictures from our Family.

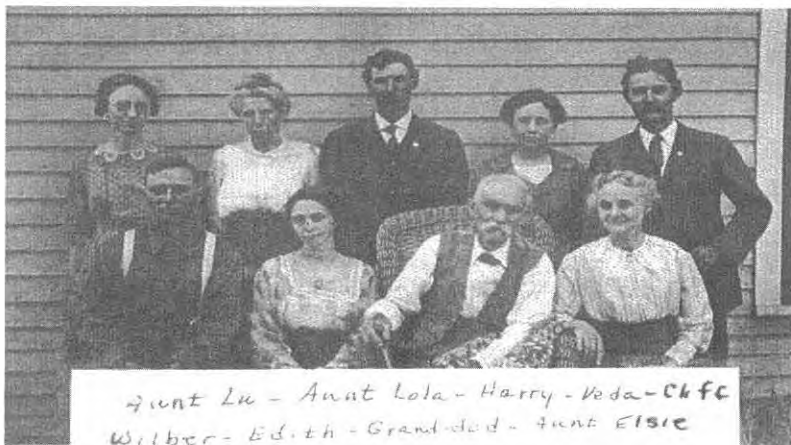

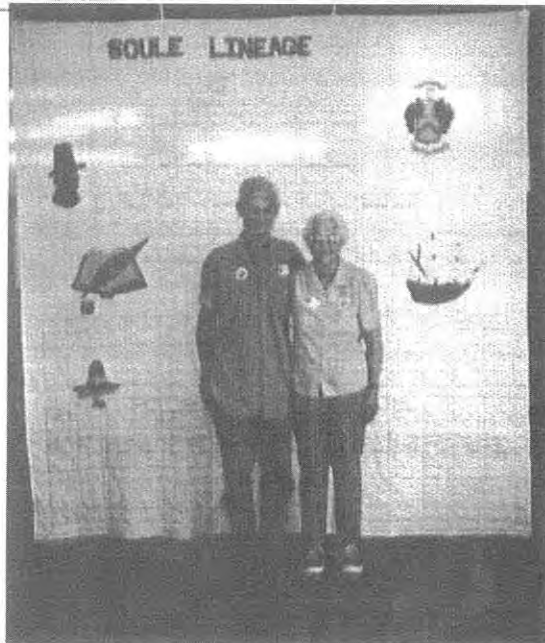

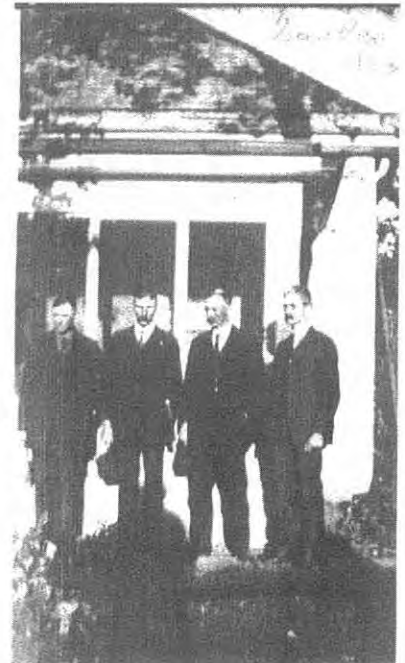



I decided to search from a different angle. I found a male cousin that descended from Hiram Sowle/Sowles and a Soule Kindred cousin whose lineage has been proven back to George Soule of the Mayflower and collected their DNA and had it processed. I had the Y-DNA test done through the Sowle surname. Any male with the last name Sowle (or any version of the name) can have this test compared with my results if you sign a release form when submitting your DNA. The website I used was familytreedna.com or call 713-868-1438 and ask for a Y-DNA kit. The University of Arizona processes the results.

GARNER AND LILLIS SOWLE/SOULE

In my continued search for my G-G-G-Grandfather, Hiram Soule I have searched other Soule families that were living in Eaton County Michigan about 1850. Hiram Soule married Sarah Boyer October 7, 1847 in the Township of Roxand, where they both resided.

On the 1850 Michigan Census, Eaton County, Eaton Township I found Garner and Lillis Soule, both are age 57, they were born in Rhode Island. In 1860 I found Garner Soule living in Shiawassee County, MI with his daughter Henrietta Reed. Garner died 10-21-1877 in Shiawassee County, MI. Lillis died before 1860, I have not been able to find where she was buried.

In my search I decided to try and find Garner in Ohio to see how many children he and Lillis had. On the 1820 census Garner is listed in Trumbull County, Weathersfield Twp., Ohio – 1830 census, Portage Co., Charlestown Twp., Ohio, 1840 census Garner was listed as living in Preble County, Ohio. When I searched for him in Preble County, Ohio the census pages did not go to page 176. I called the Preble County library and asked if they would look it up on their original census reel and send me a copy. They said those pages were not their county, so I decided to search in Portage Co. since it was close to Trumbull Co. and he lived there in 1830-1840 Ohio censuses, Portage Co., Charlestown Twp.

I did find three children, but I do feel that two children are still missing. Below I will list the three children, their spouses and children.

Henrietta Soule, B: 7-19-1822, OH, Married: Samuel Reed, 12-5-1844, Geauga Co., OH, D: 1-11-1878 Shiawassee Co., MI, Children: Garner, James, Pauline, Alanson, William T., Sarah A and Mary Jane Reed.

Silas B. Soule, B: ca. 1820, OH, Married: Hepzibeth McNelly, 8-13-1846, Portage Co., OH, D: 1894, MI, Children: George W., Waty Ann or Walter A. and Prudence M. Soule.

Patience Soule, B: ca. 1825, OH, Married: Solon McNelly, 11-5-1846, Portage Co., OH, D: 6-10-1873, MI, Children: Garner, Samuel, Henrietta and Lillis McNelly.

There is still much research needed, but I thought the members of Soule Kindred would find this interesting since this generation of Garner and Lillis Soule has not yet been uncovered. HENRI SOULÉ

Pierre Franey's memoir, "A Chef's Tale: A Memoir of Food, France and America" introduced me to the man whom Craig Claiborne, in a formal appreciation in the *Times* called, "the Michelangelo, the Mozart and the Leonardo of the French restaurant in America," one Henri Soulé.

Franey and Soulé worked together in the glass-fronted restaurant at the top of the French Pavillon, the French government's exhibit at the 1939 World's Fair in Flushing, New York.

Supervision of the dining room went to the efficient and dapper Soulé, who also spoke English. In six months' time the popular restaurant served an astonishing 136,261 meals to appreciative fairgoers.

Most of the French Restaurant staff had temporary work visas and could work only "off the books." In the spring of 1941, Soulé and his staff traveled to Buffalo, crossed over into Canada and then walked across the "peace bridge" back into the United States to claim asylum as war refugees. They were now legally able to remain in the United States where Soulé became a citizen 1946.

The grand success of the fair restaurant led to the opening of Le Pavillon, at 5 East Fifty-fifth Street in New York City when Henri was 30 years of age. He brought staff members from the fair and nearly the same menu, but the venue was designed to resemble the beautiful Café de Paris where he had been employed in Paris. The opening night private gala was a free evening for the likes of the Kennedys, Vanderbilts, Cabots and Rockefellers who dined upon caviar, *sole bonne femme*, *poulet braisé au champagne*, cheese, and strawberries and cream for dessert.

C u s t o m e r s appreciated Soulé but he was often feared by the staff. He was an authoritarian figure with a "penguin-shaped body and precious mannerisms." He began "his work with a fanfare, raising both of his arms above his head and vibrating them the way a minstrel singer might, the ostensible intention being to get the sleeves of his tux down a bit out of the



way." Henri never entered the kitchen when the dining room was open and he always dressed in a tuxedo for dinner.

Franey recalls that Soulé's "La Pavillon was running a culinary university, training French cooks and dining room staff for service throughout America." In 1954 the French government awarded Soulé the *chevalier de la Légion d'honneur*, the only French restaurateur in America to be so recognized.

Henri Soulé died in 1966 of a heart attack. Le Pavillon survived until 1971, when it closed for good.



I came upon a little booklet, a guide actually, which measures about 2 x 3", "A Guide to New York Restaurants by The Editors of Holiday." It reads, in part:

"New York today surpasses all other cities in culinary excitements. But there are ten thousand restaurants in Manhattan alone, and only a very small percentage are worthy of note.

As a guide, Silas Spitzer prepared, with the cooperation of the Editors of Holiday, a Holiday Handbook of New York Restaurants for the all-New York issue, October 1959. This booklet contains addresses, phone numbers and brief descriptions of his 105 choices. They are listed alphabetically within four groupings: *elegant and distinguished*, *notably fine food*, *colorful and unusual*, and *other notable restaurants*."

Le Pavillon ranked among the eleven "elegant and distinguished," it reads:

"LE PAVILLON, 111 E. 57TH STREET/PLAZA 3-8388
Owner Henri Soulé is known among restaurant professionals as "the greatest of them all." He has improved this marvelous place from year to year until it is now close to that pitch of perfection to which he is dedicated. The clientele and the setting are worthy of one another. The food is exquisite, the wines are fabulous. Few complain, for an evening here is something even the rich and pampered consider a great experience. Expensive."

A second restaurant, La Côte Basque, was opened in 1958 by Soulé. The restaurant has been known for years as one of New York's most charming and romantic restaurants, frequented by royalty, heads of state and movie stars. La Cote Basque still exists, at 60 West 55th Street, New York City, keeping alive the spirit of the old Le Pavillon and may be viewed at www.venueview.com.

Soule Ancestors in the Vital Records of Maine

Project: FY 2003-6

The below tables taken from Maine Vital Records give an indication to Soule Family researchers of the lack of past research efforts which have been performed, regarding the Vital Records of Maine. Maine (after the State of Massachusetts) was one of the earliest settlements of descendents of George Soule – Mayflower Pilgrim. Large concentrations of Soule descendents lived there and spread over the entire state.

The Archives of Soule Kindred has confirmed many of these George Soule descendents. As can be seen by reviewing the "Unidentified" table II it is obvious that there is nearly as many on this list as in the "Confirmed" table I. This shows an interesting example of the number of Soule descendents that might possibly be discovered pending future concentrated research efforts.

These tables are considered to be only a small "tip of the iceberg" and have been put together to show future possibilities by the Soule Kindred Historians Office. This project was mentioned long ago as a portion of the overall project previously entitled: *Soule Kindred Research Network: Data Bank* and has been underway for some time. The Soule Kindred Historians Office has recently acquired some fairly extensive research materials pertaining to the State of Maine and plans are underway to acquire more as they become available.

In addition to the acquisition of the above material, Soule Kindred has been in contact with two Soule Family researchers who are presently located in the State of Maine who have shown interest in performing research as "Field Consultants" in expanding this project. Should this prove a fruitful endeavor, then on-going projects in the Soule Kindred Historians Office could be greatly expanded.

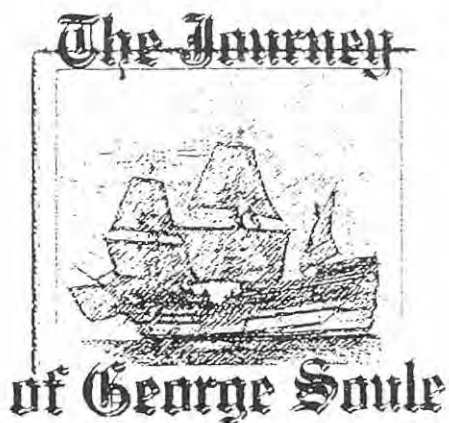
